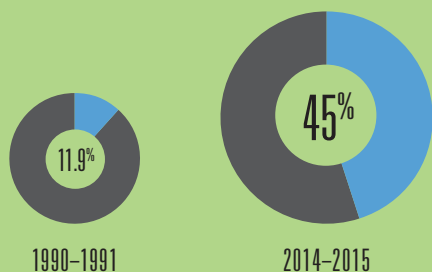

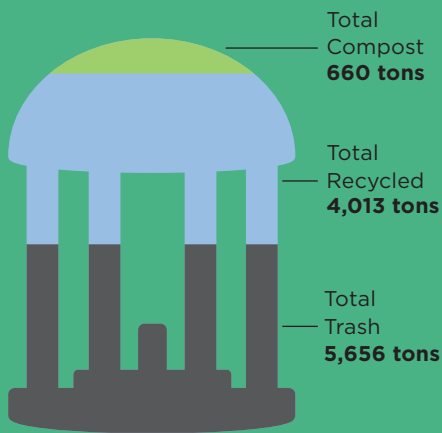

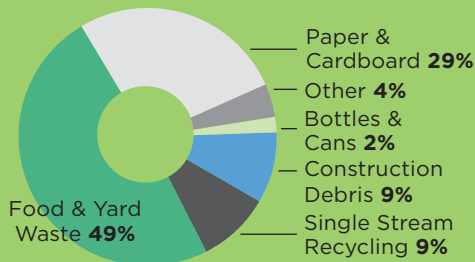

TOTAL WASTE BREAKDOWN (IN TONS)



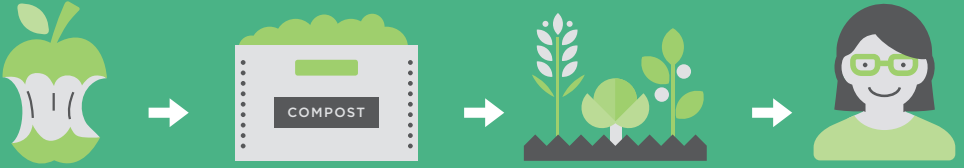
TOTAL WASTE: 10,329 TONS

RESIDENTIAL COMPOST

In addition to existing food waste collection programs in dining halls and catering kitchens, 2015 marked the official launch of the Residential Compost program! These efforts resulted in an entire ton of food waste collected from eight residential communities. The food waste is chopped, watered and turned to create compost that is used for growing fresh produce at the Carolina Campus Community Garden. The produce is then harvested and distributed weekly to lower-income UNC employees. We are closing the loop with food waste right here on campus!

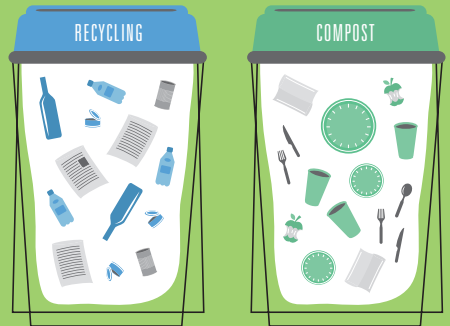
