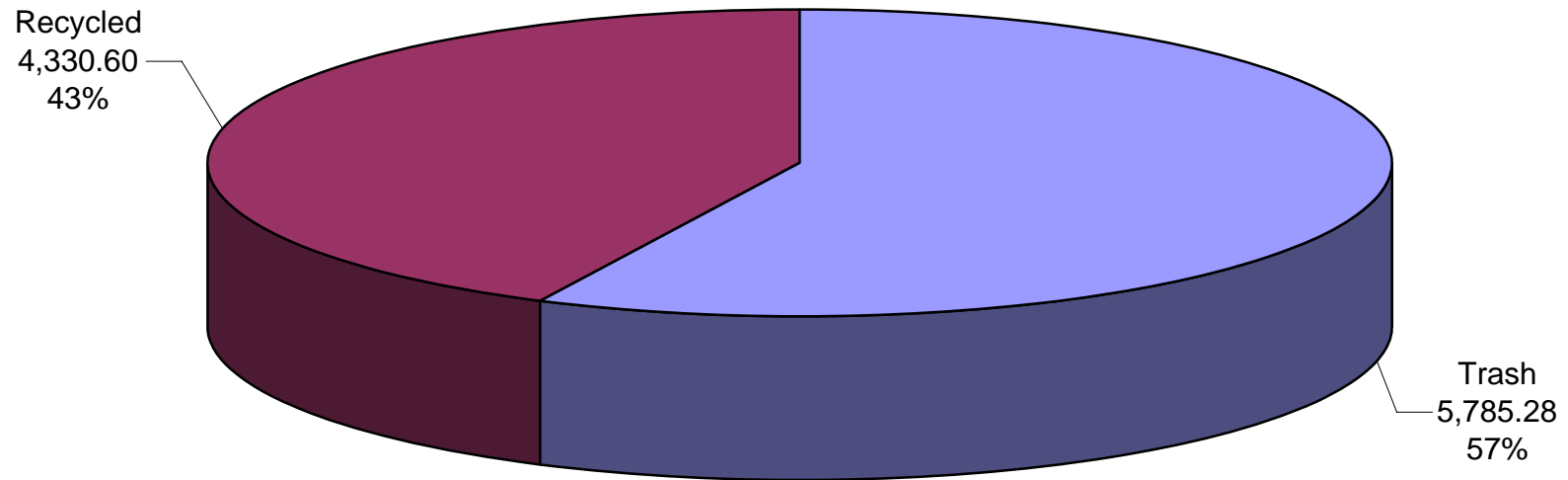
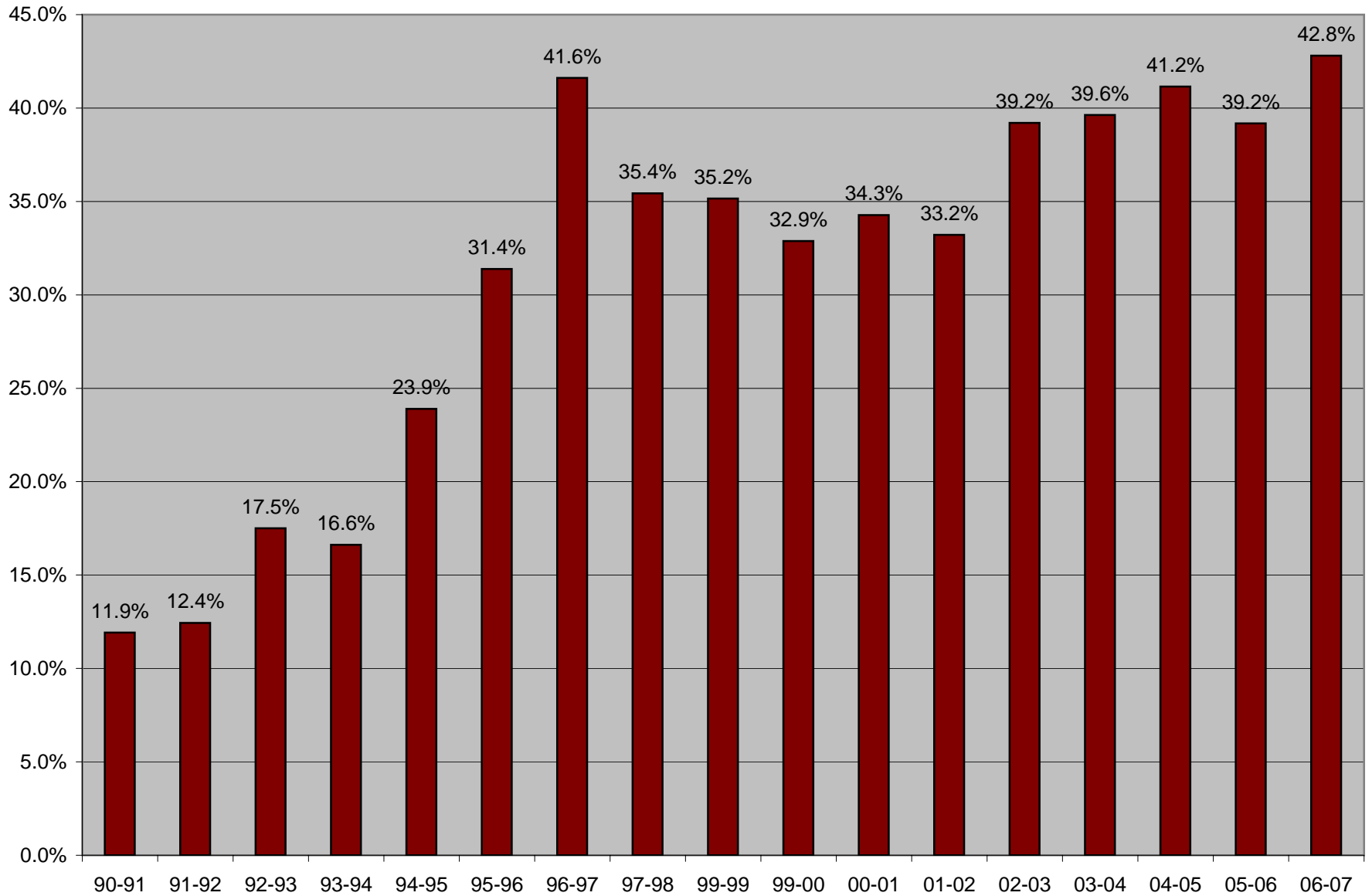


Amount Landfilled and Recycled 2006-2007 (tons)

(does not include coal ash)



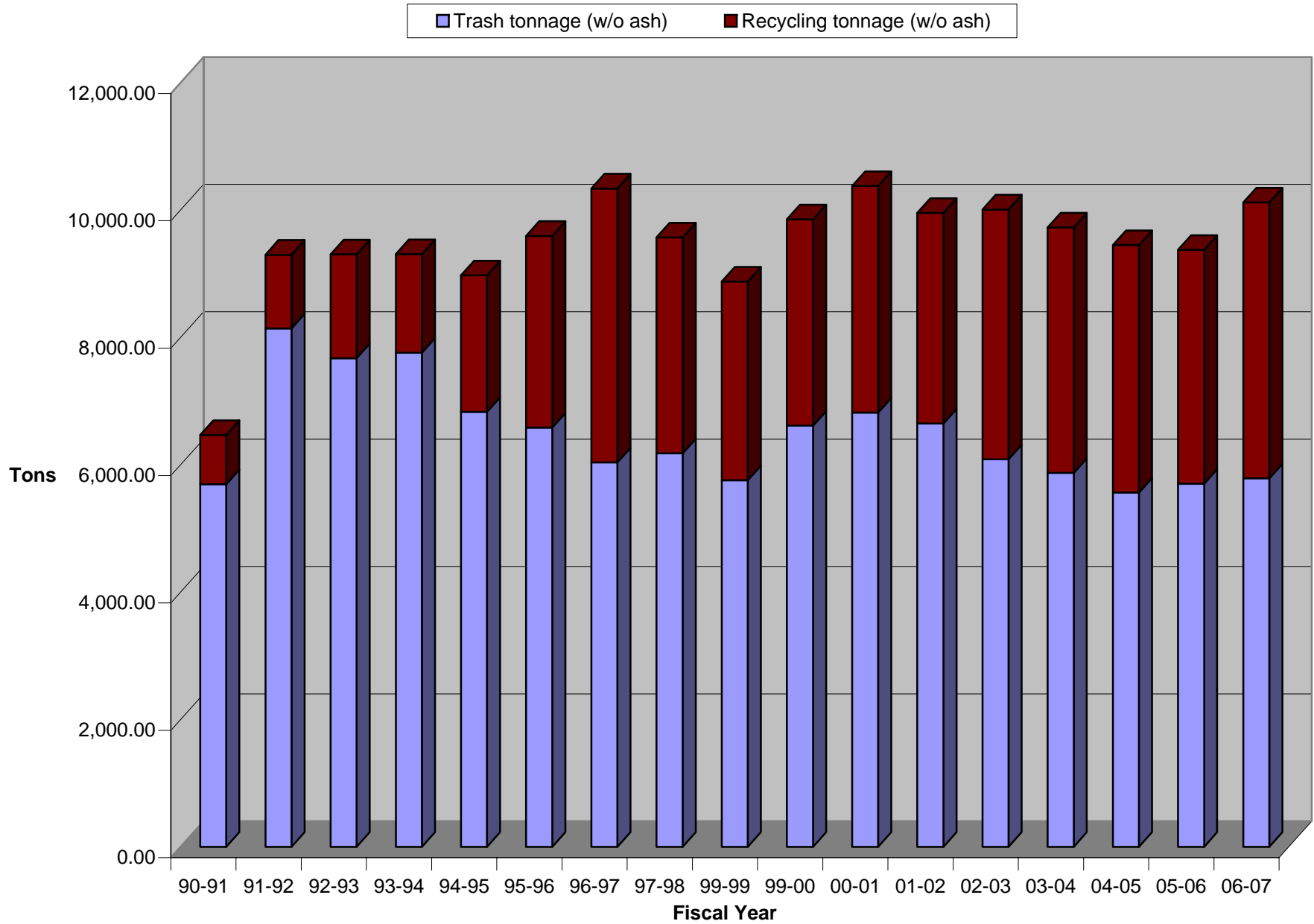
Recycling Rate History

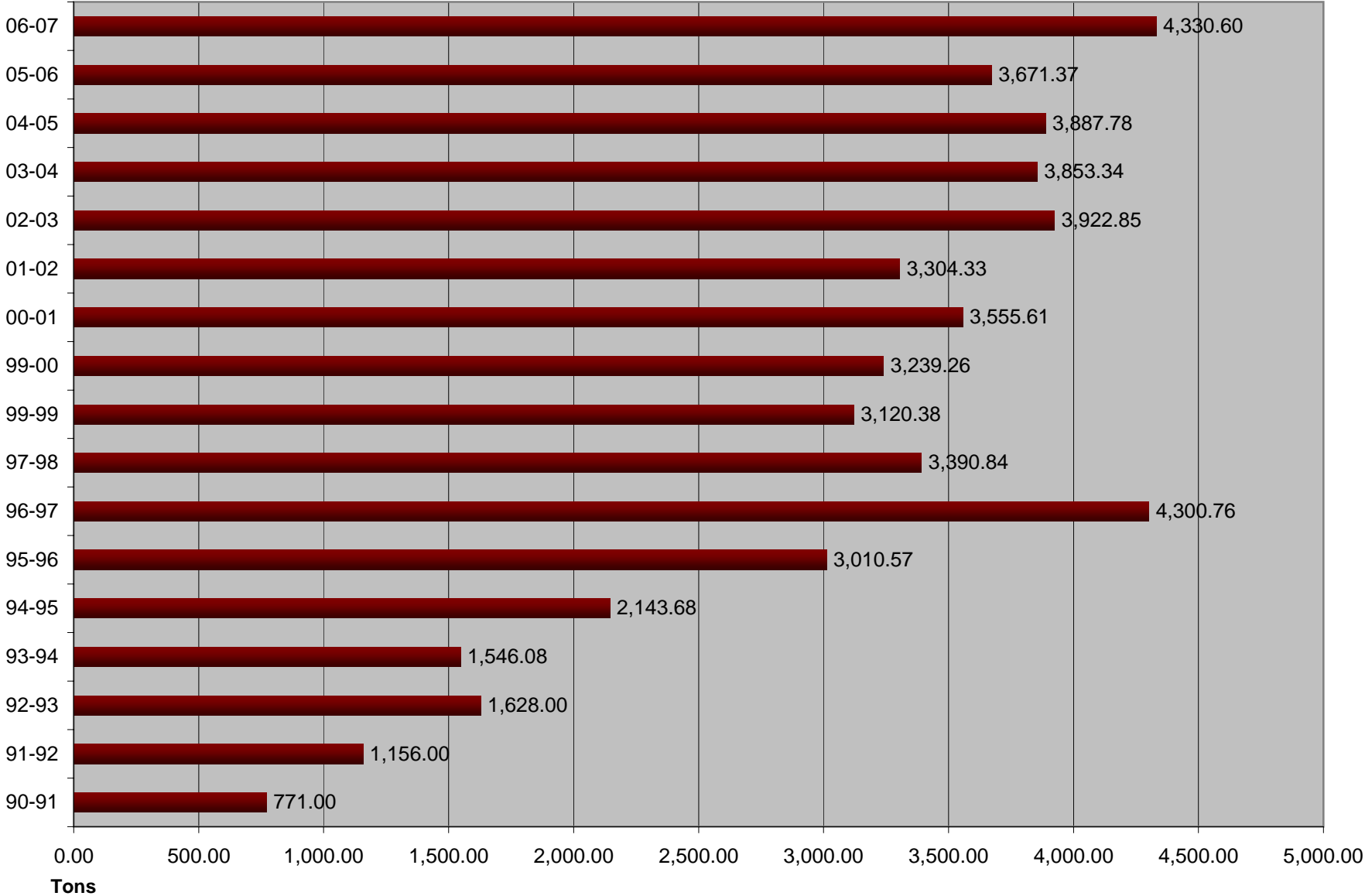

UNC-Chapel Hill Waste Disposal & Recycling Trends (without coal ash)



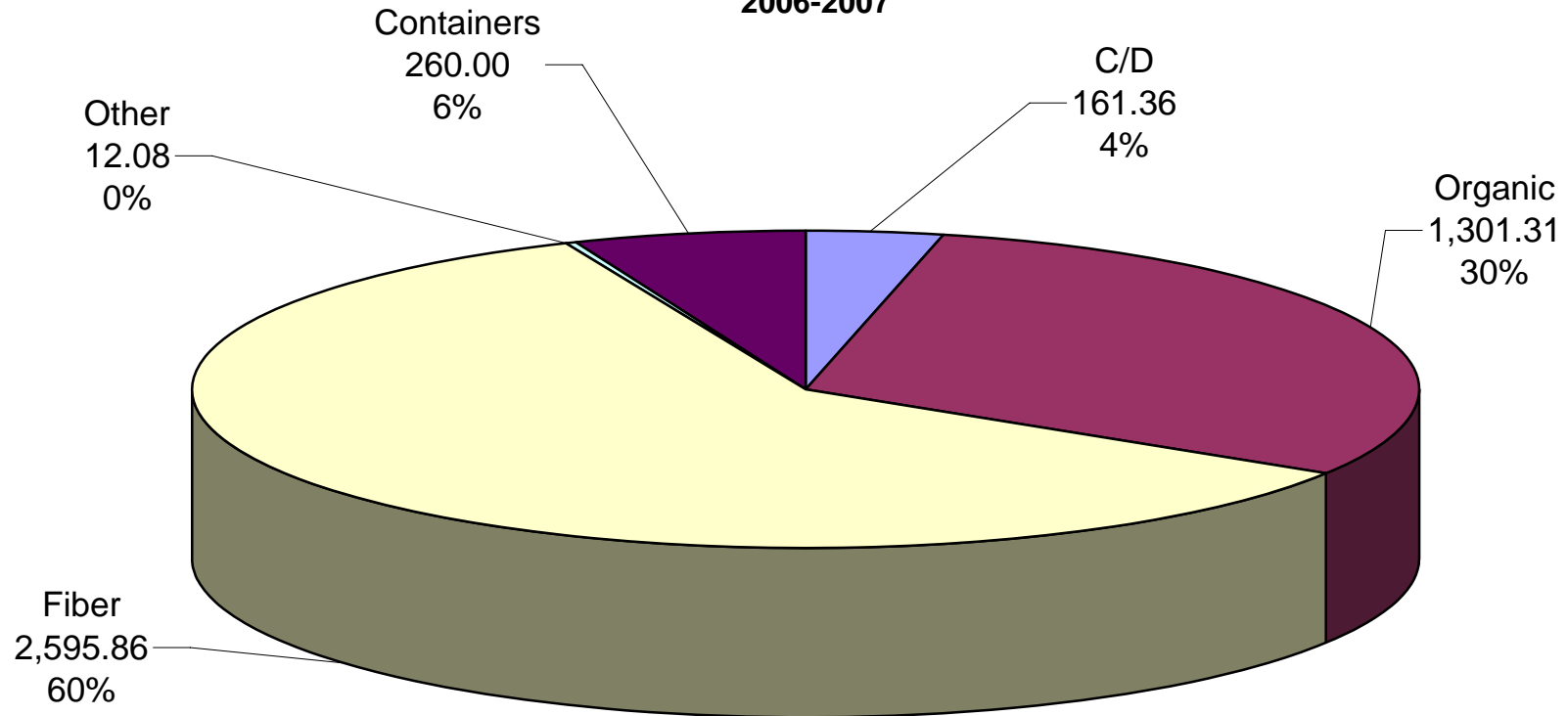

Confidential Paper Tonnages



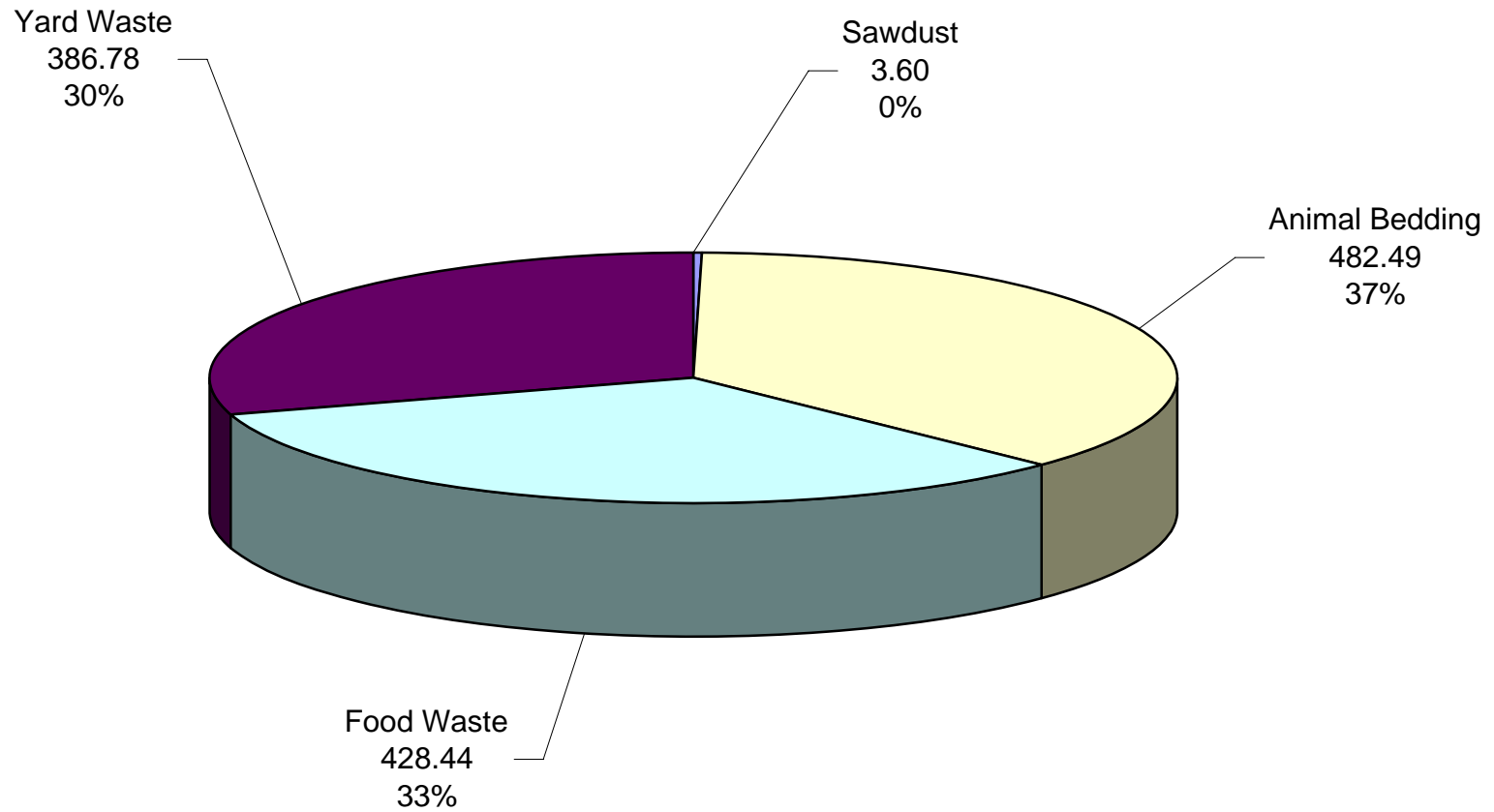

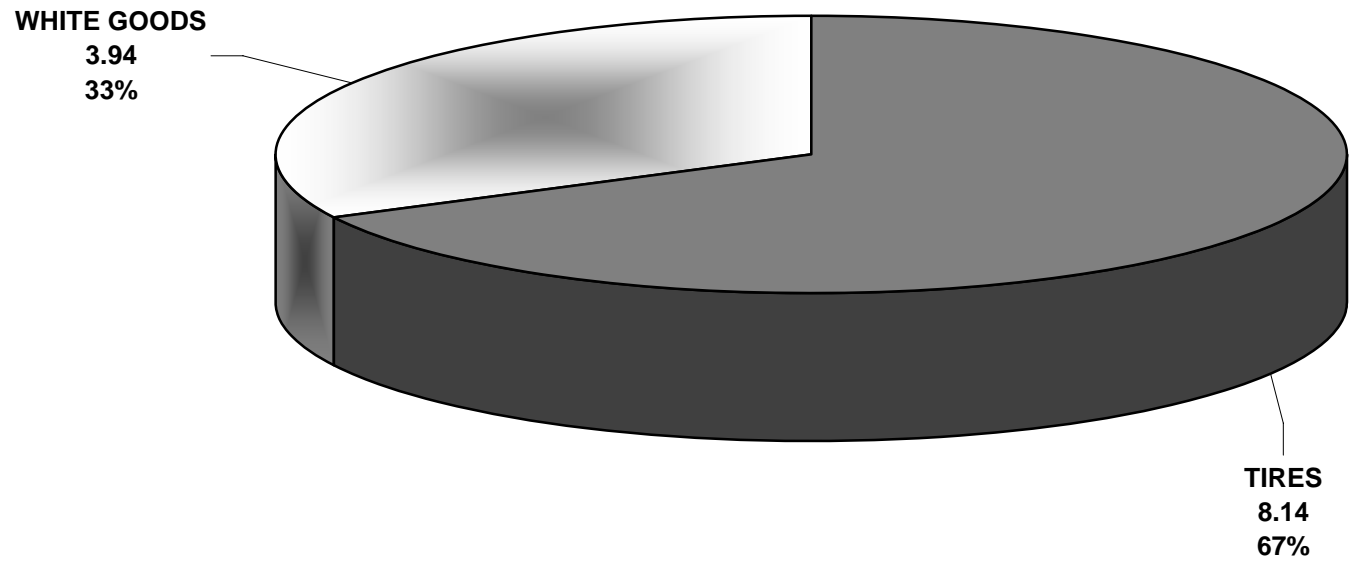

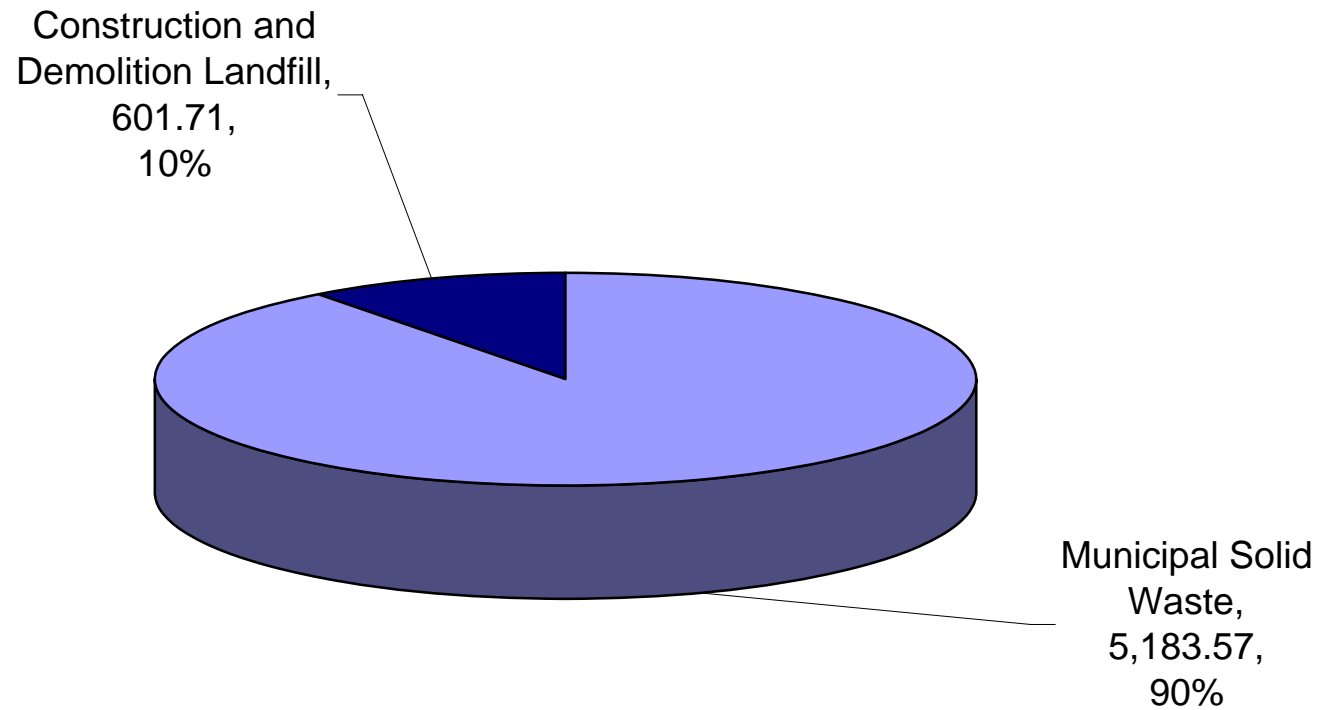


Waste Landfilled

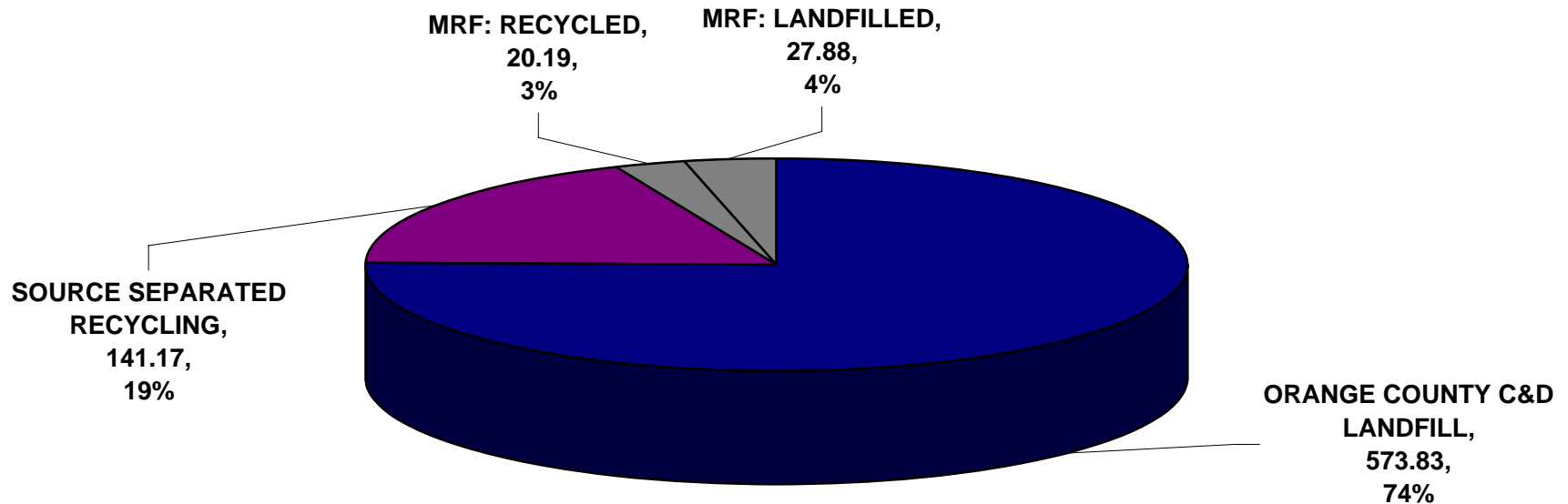

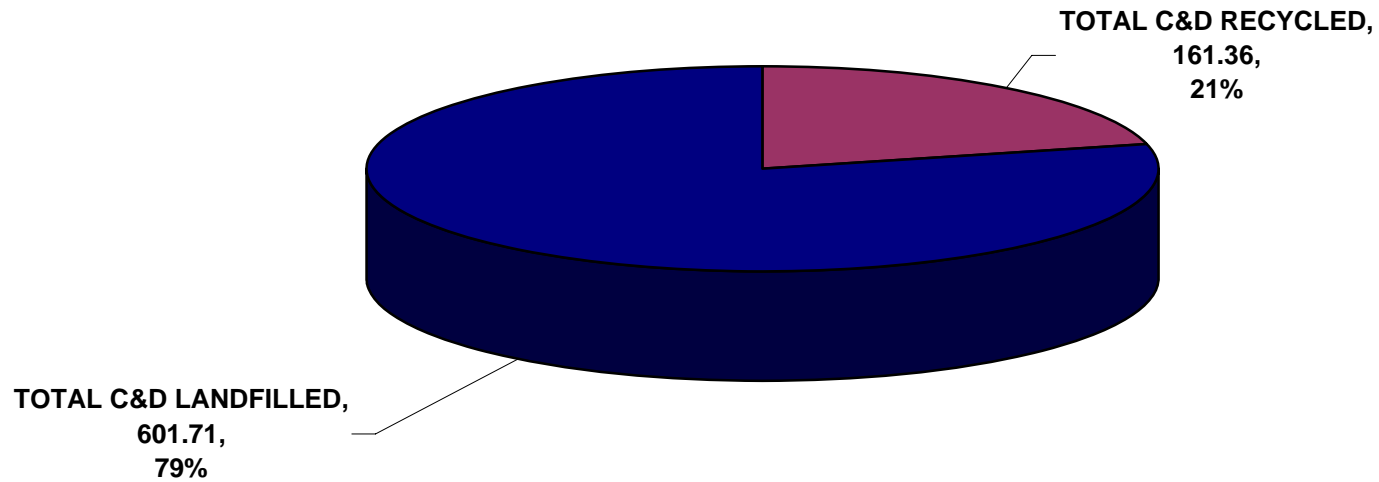

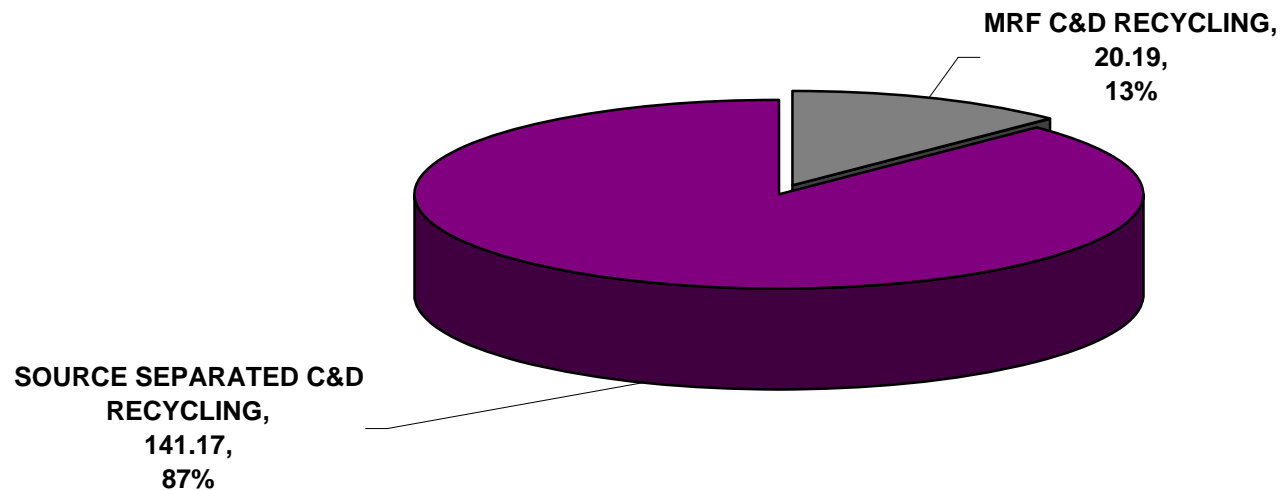
MRF stands for Material Recovery Facility which is a facility that separates mixed loads into materials that can be recycled and those for which no market exists (thus they are landfilled).

48.07 tons were taken to a MRF. The only MRF used this year by Carolina was PCM. PCM reported a 42% average recycling rate for mixed loads processed at their facility. Note: A mixed load may contain construction and demolition waste (which is landfilled) AND materials that can be recycled (clean wood waste, pallets, scrap metal, concrete and brick, and other materials of value.)

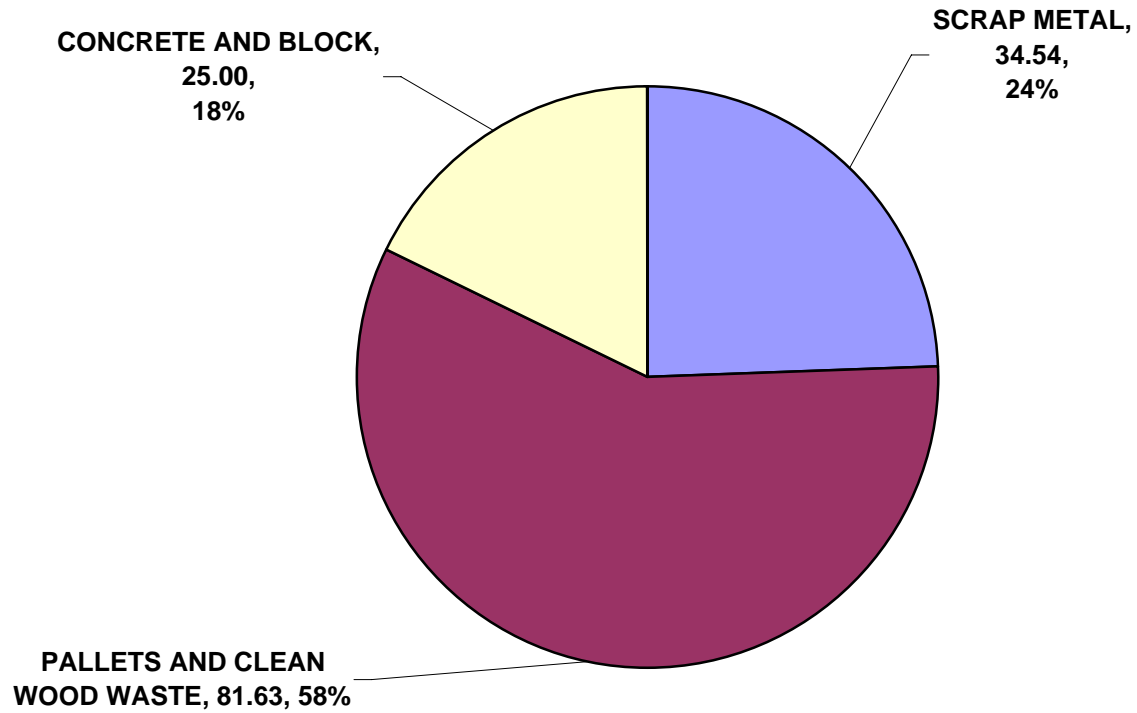


2006-2007 Total Construction and Demolition Waste Recycling 161.36 tons

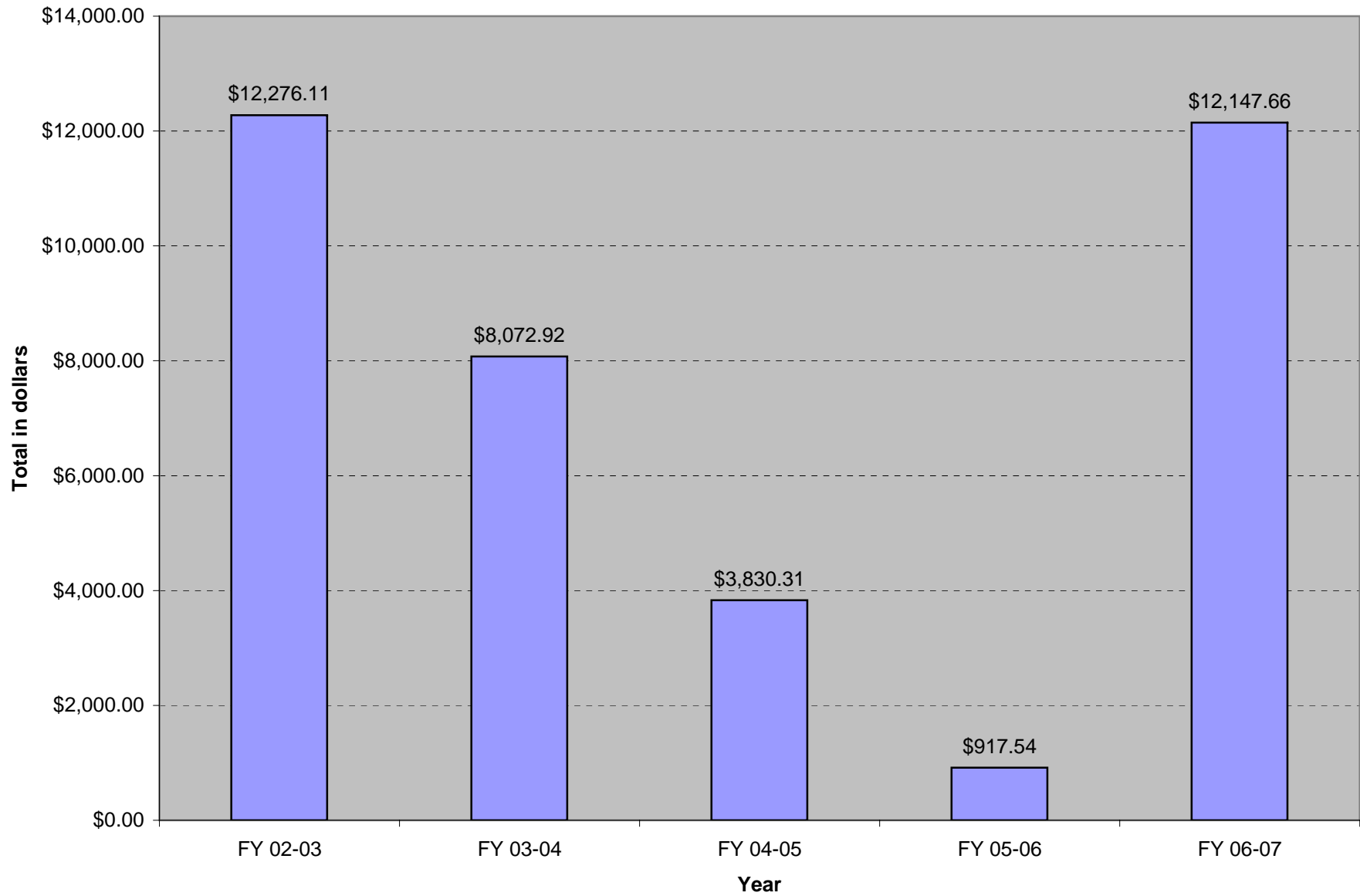

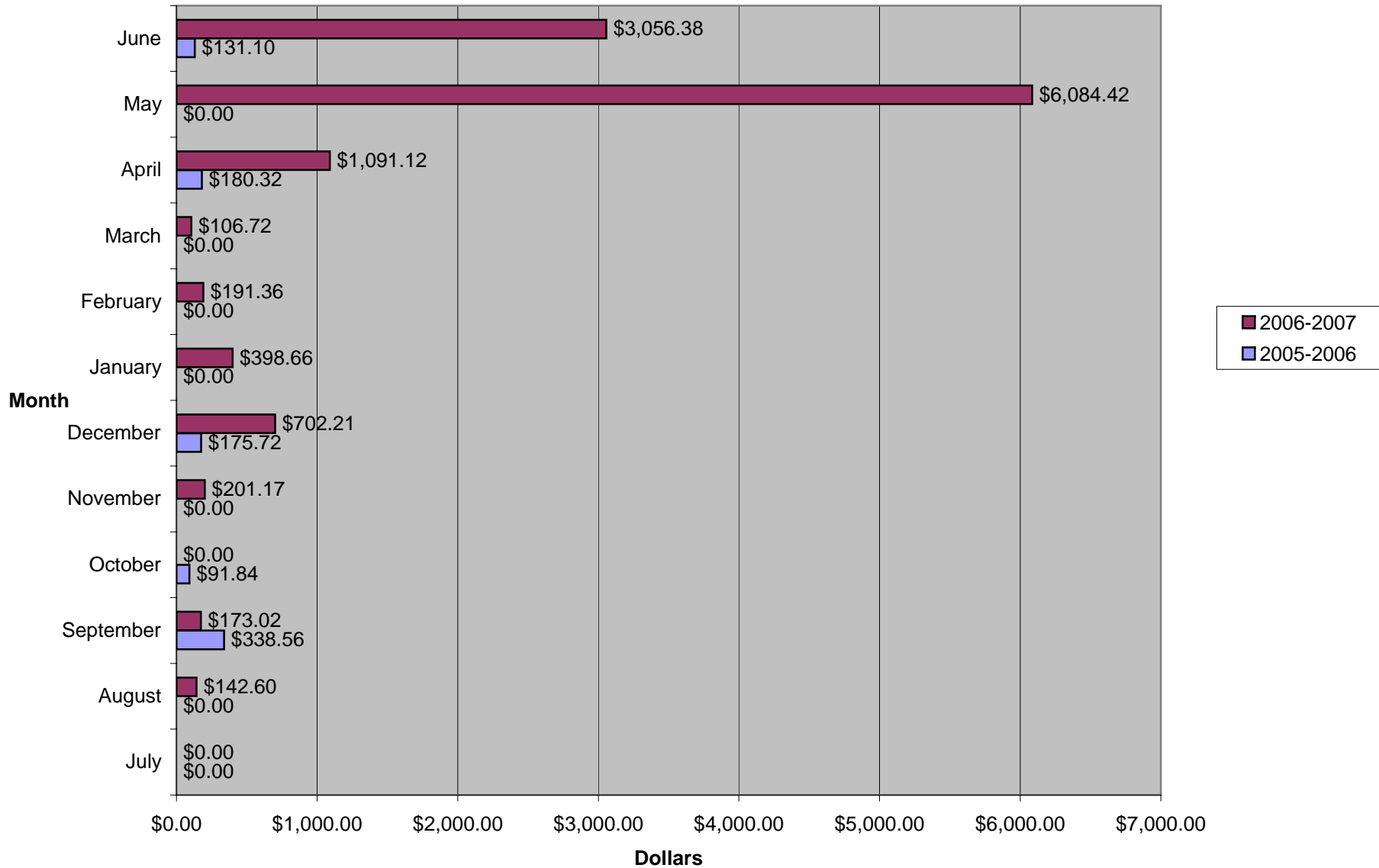
Orange County Landfill Penalties

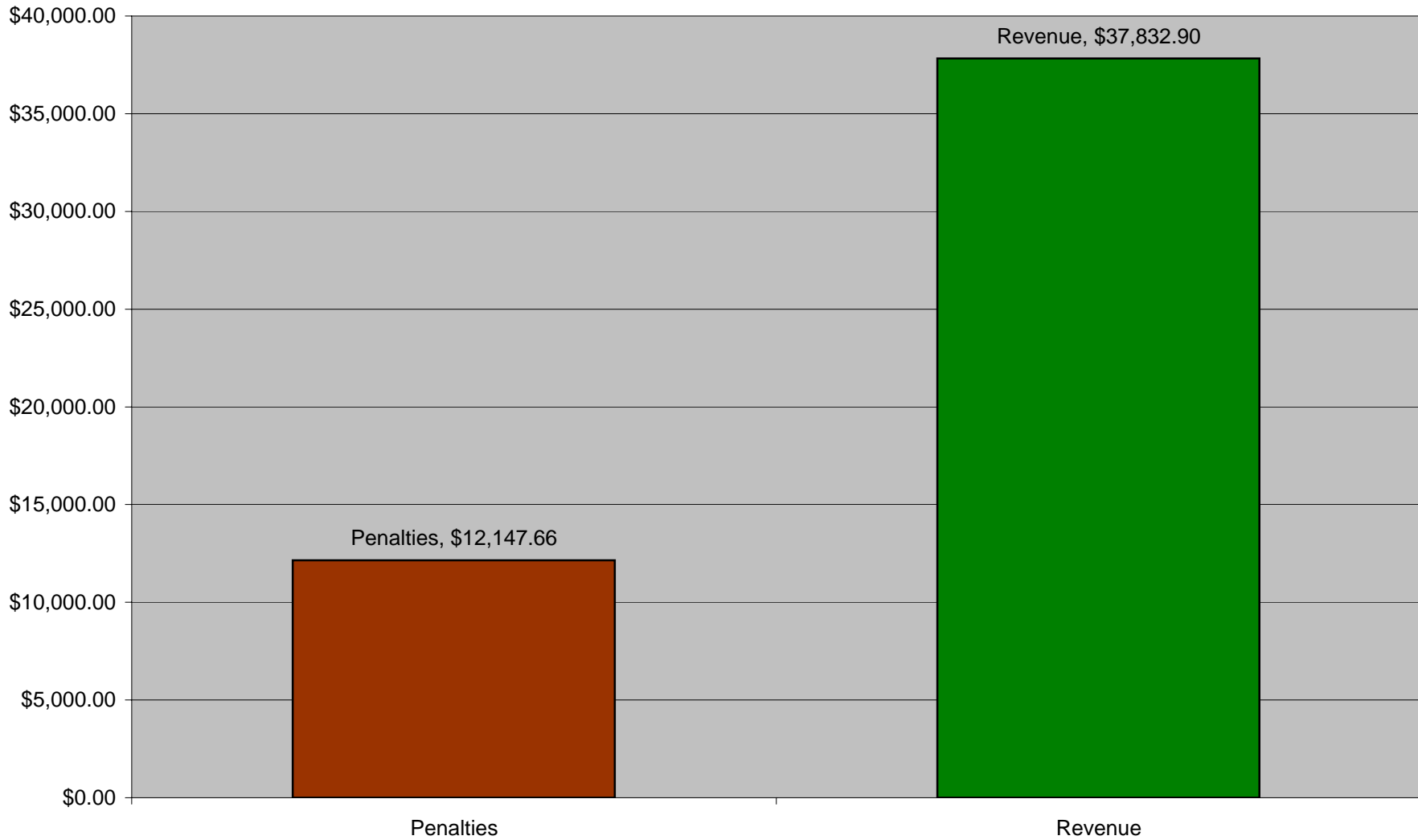
Landfill Penalties 2006-2007 (compared to the previous year)

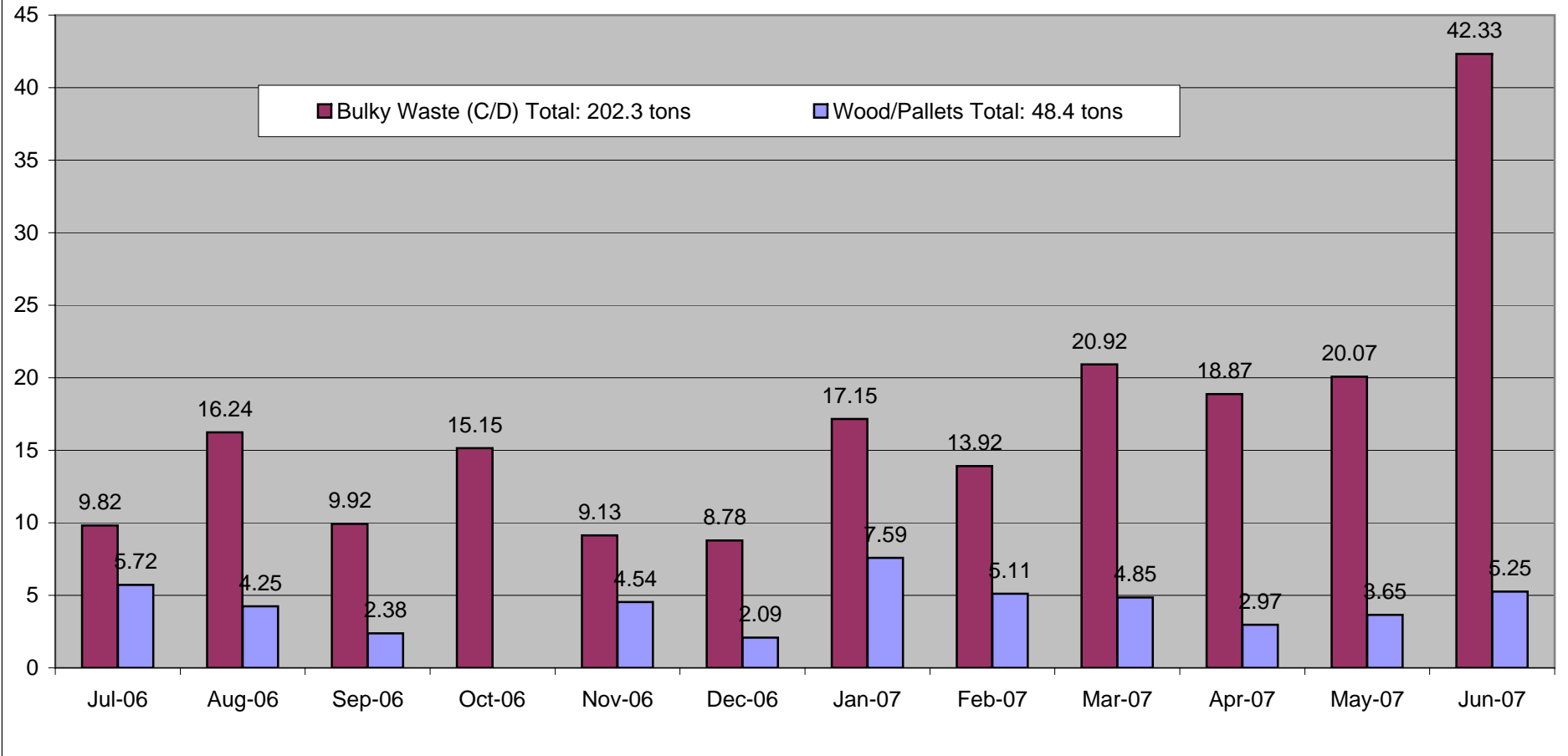


Surplus Convenience Center Tons by Month 2006-2007

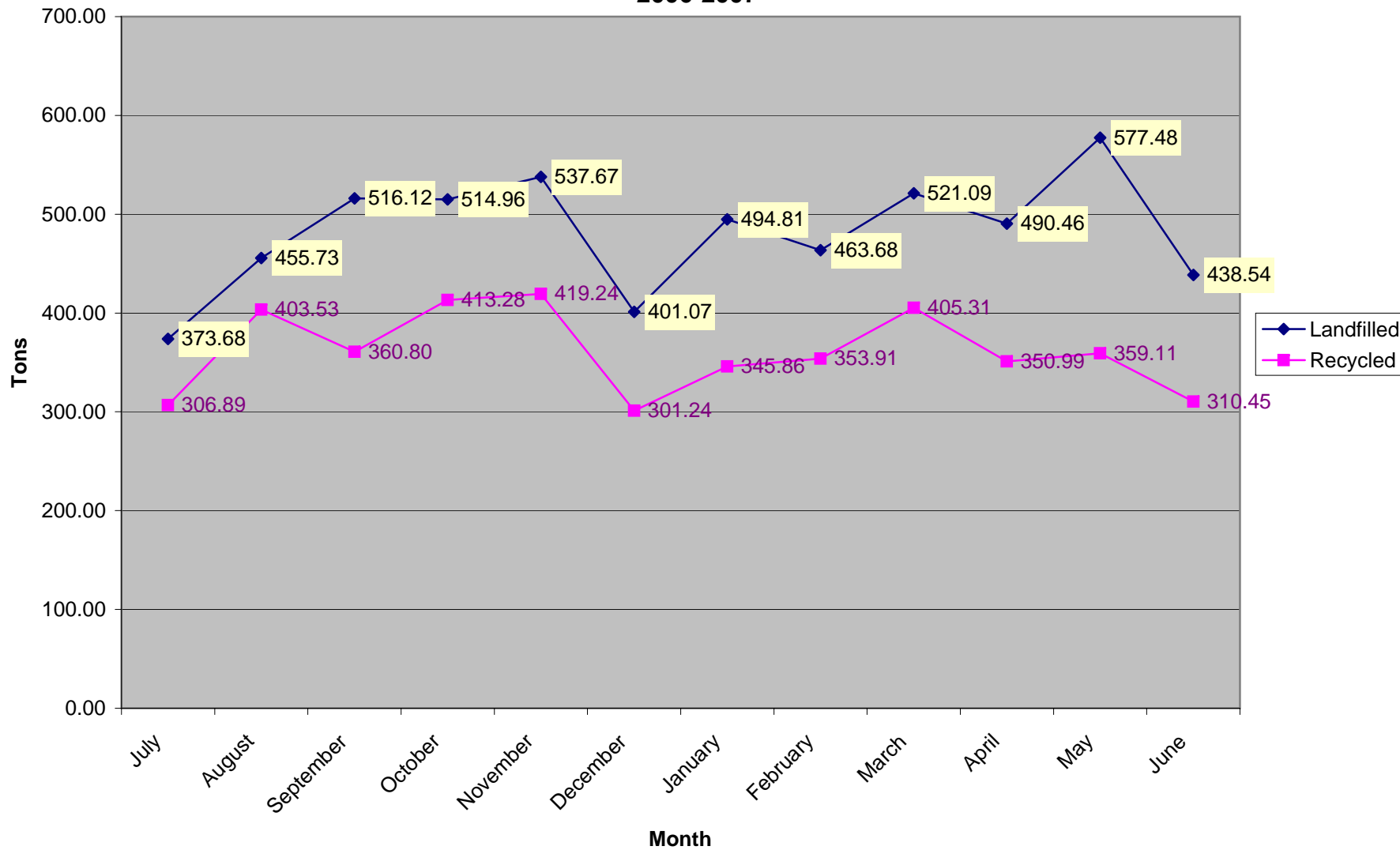

Trash & Recycling Tonnages Tons Per Month

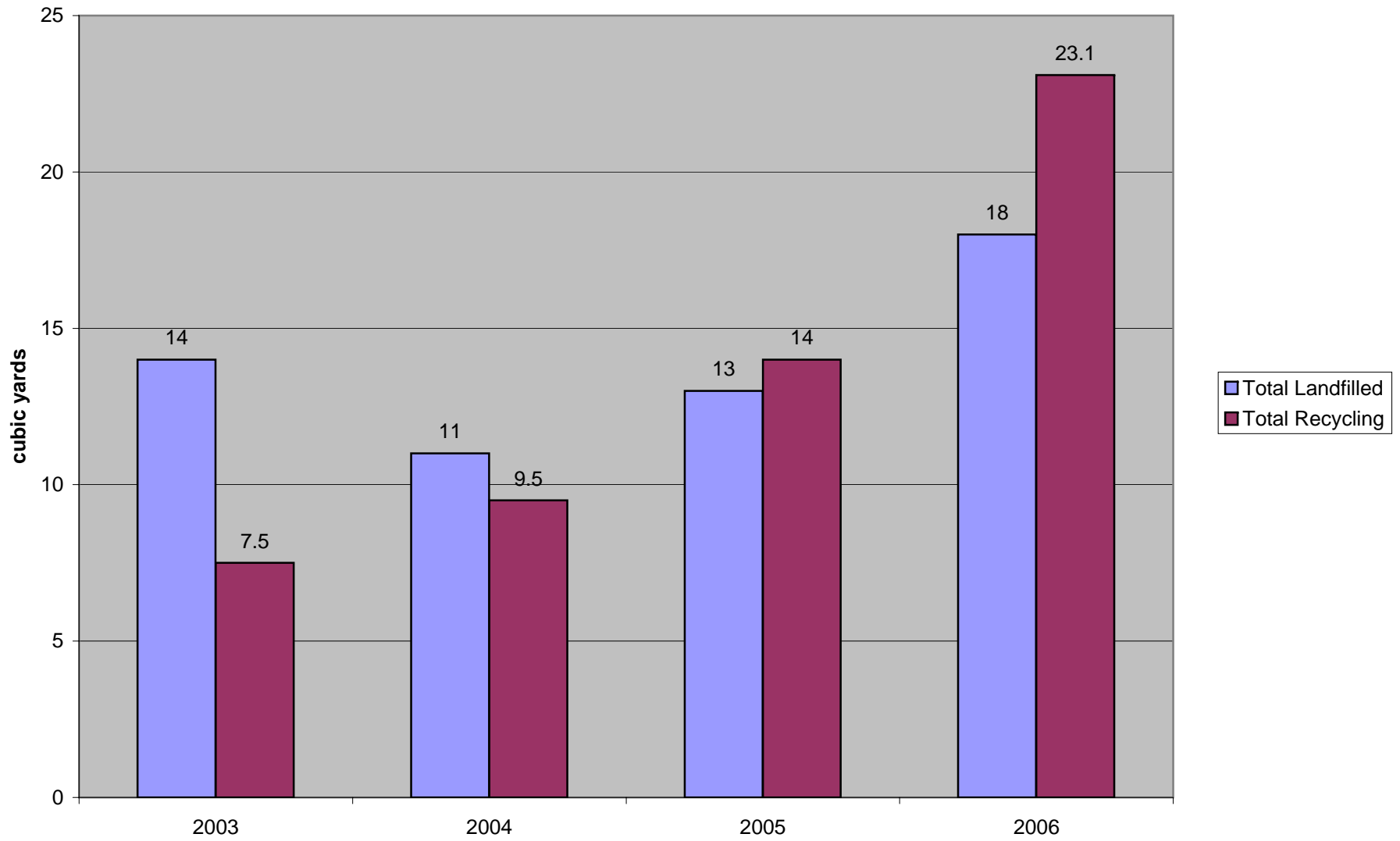

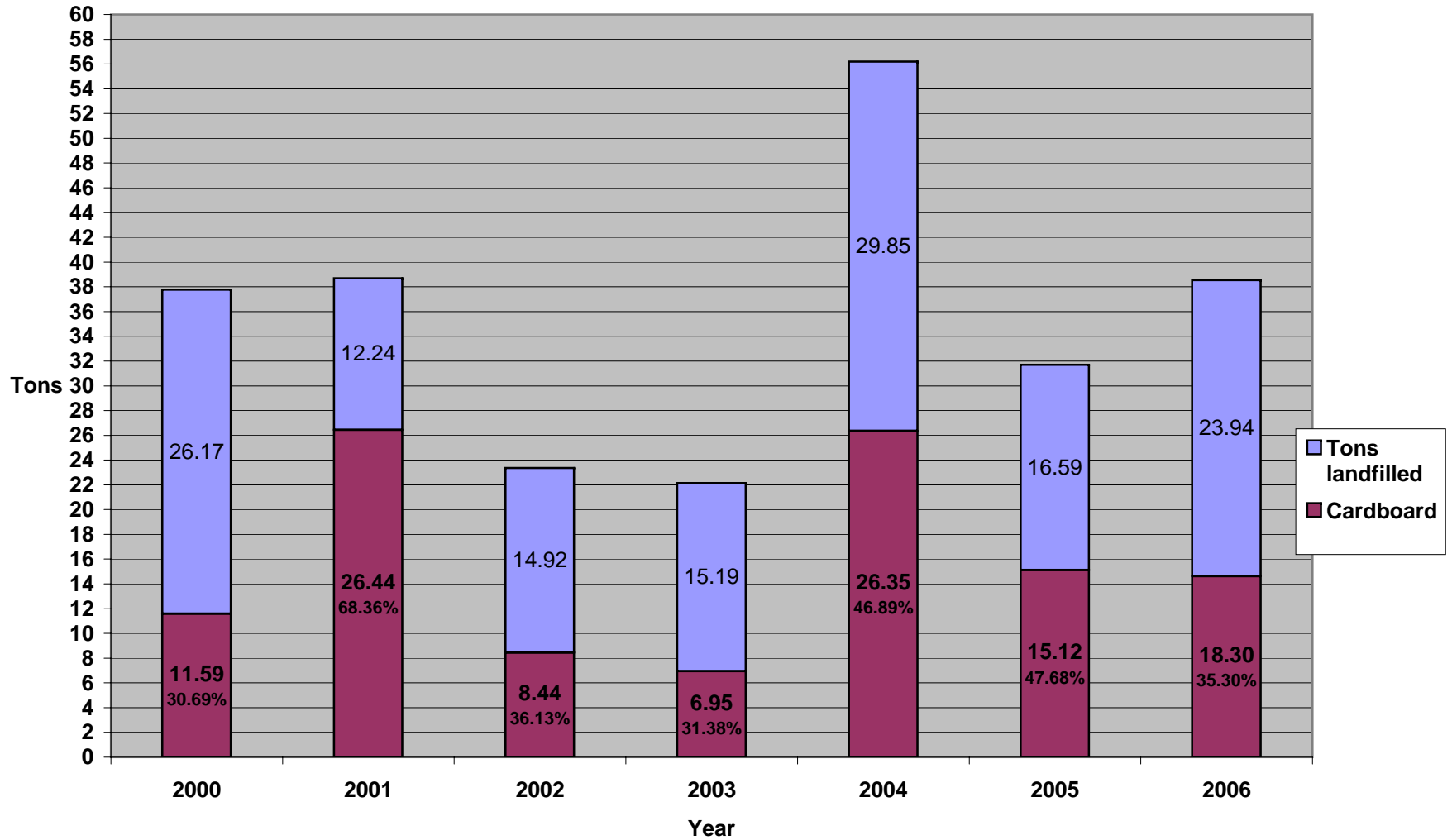
Fall Fest Trash and Recycling by volume (cubic yards)

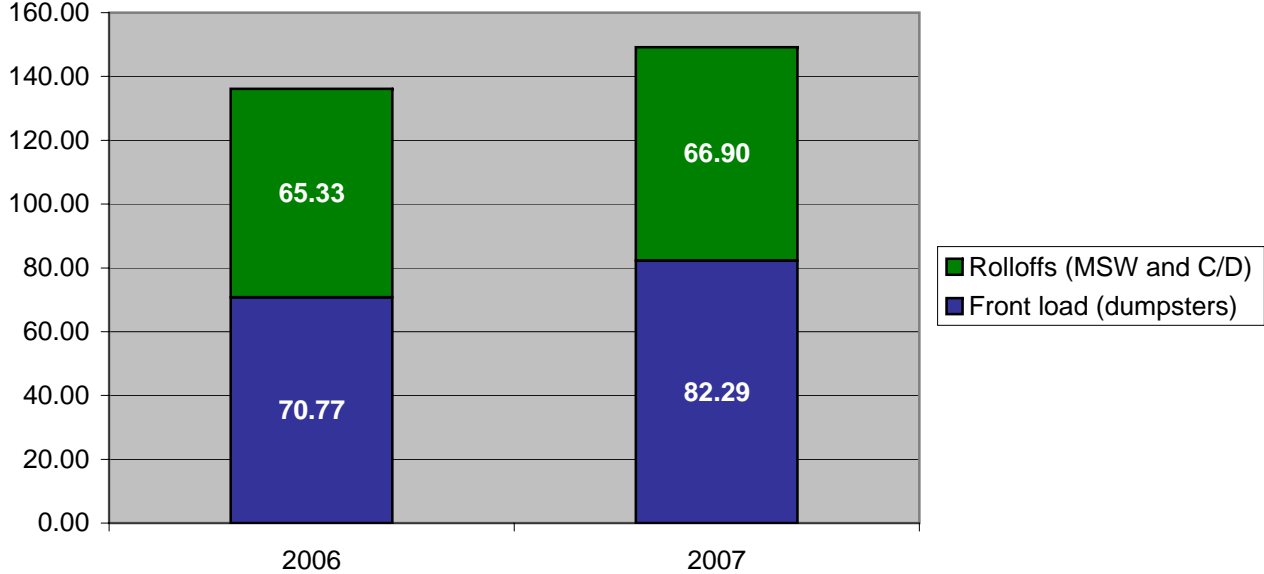

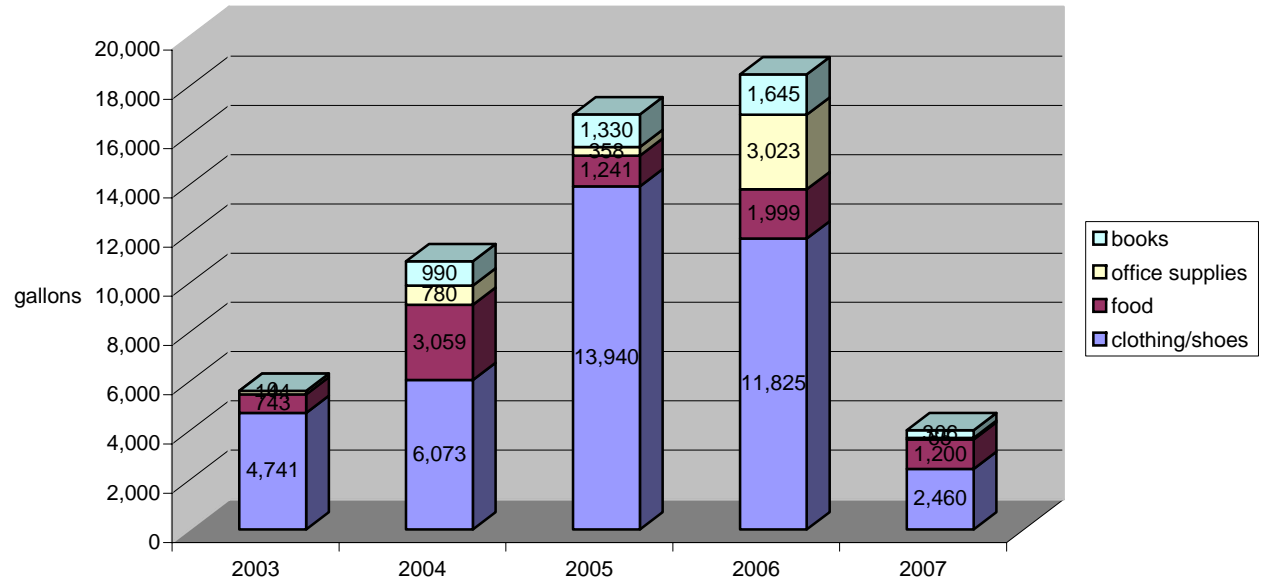

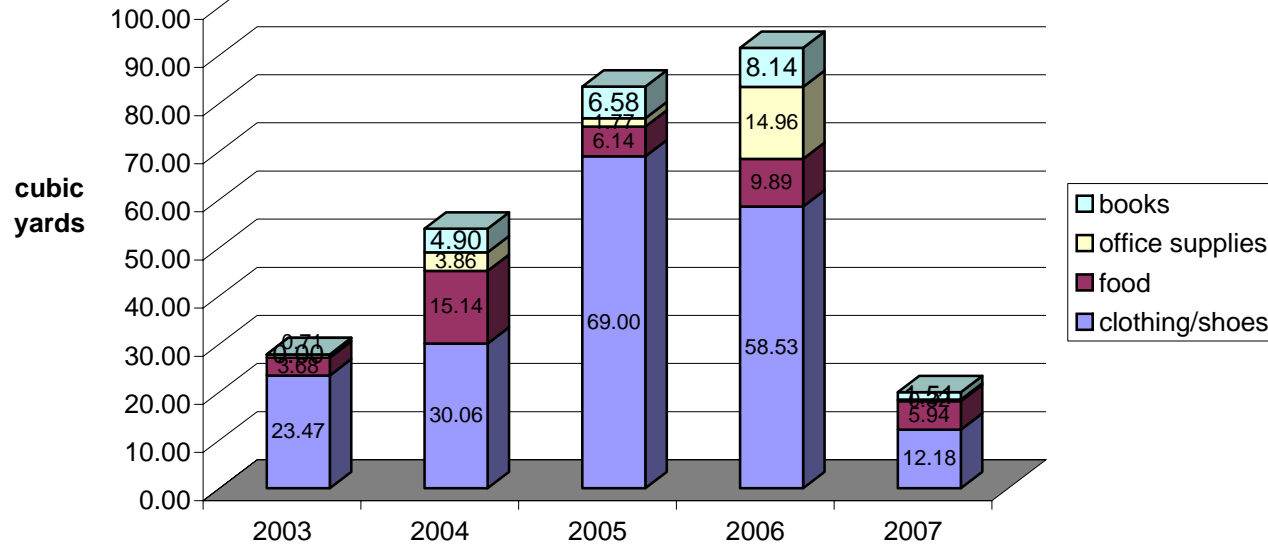


Move-out Donation stations, by volume (gallons)

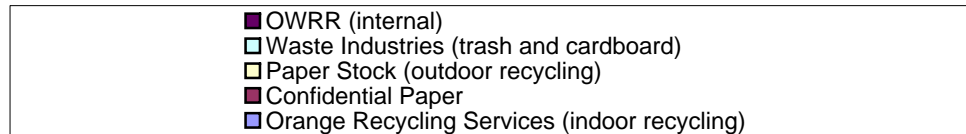
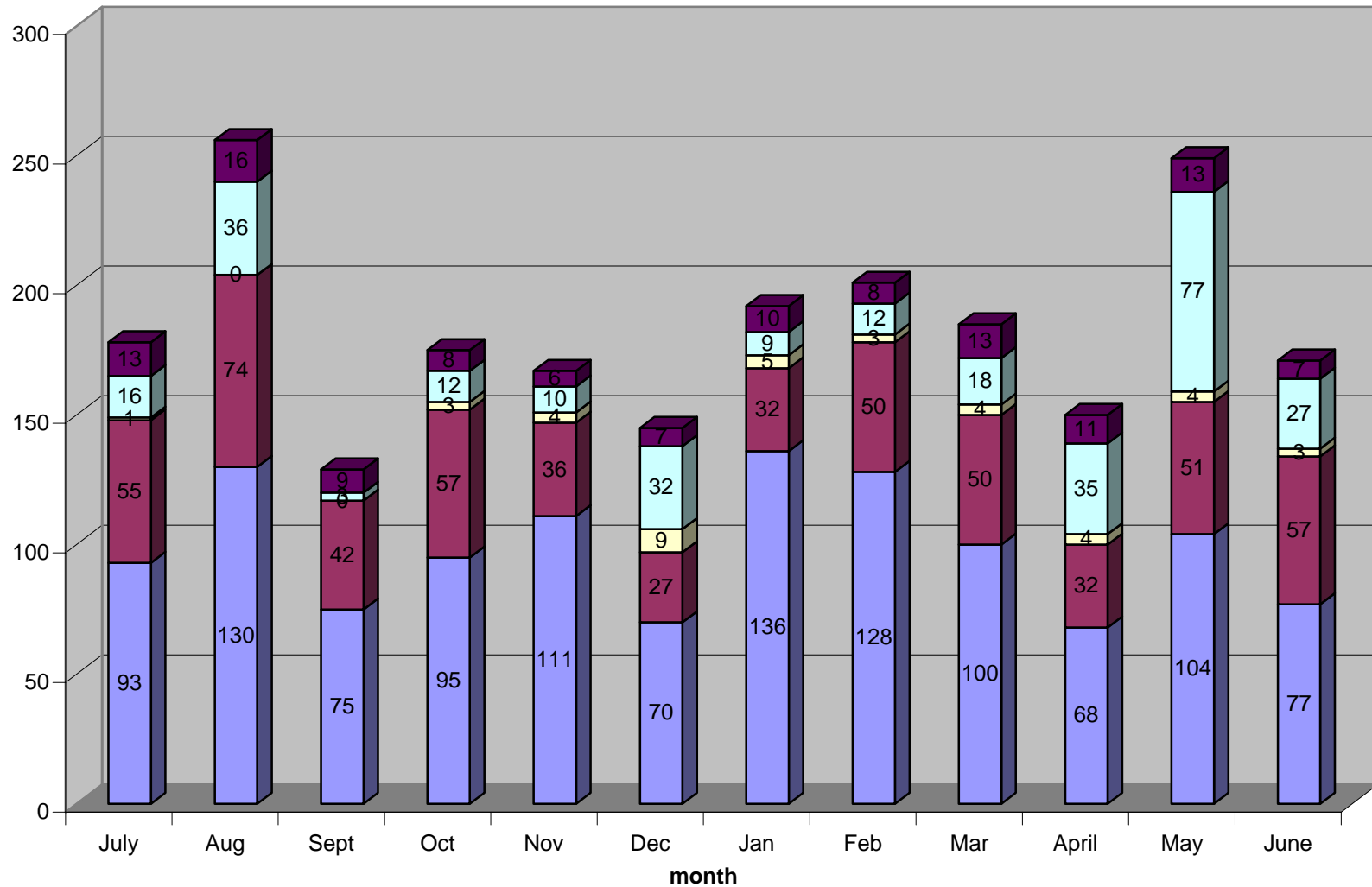


Move-out Donation stations, cubic yards

Number of Work Orders Processed, 2006-2007

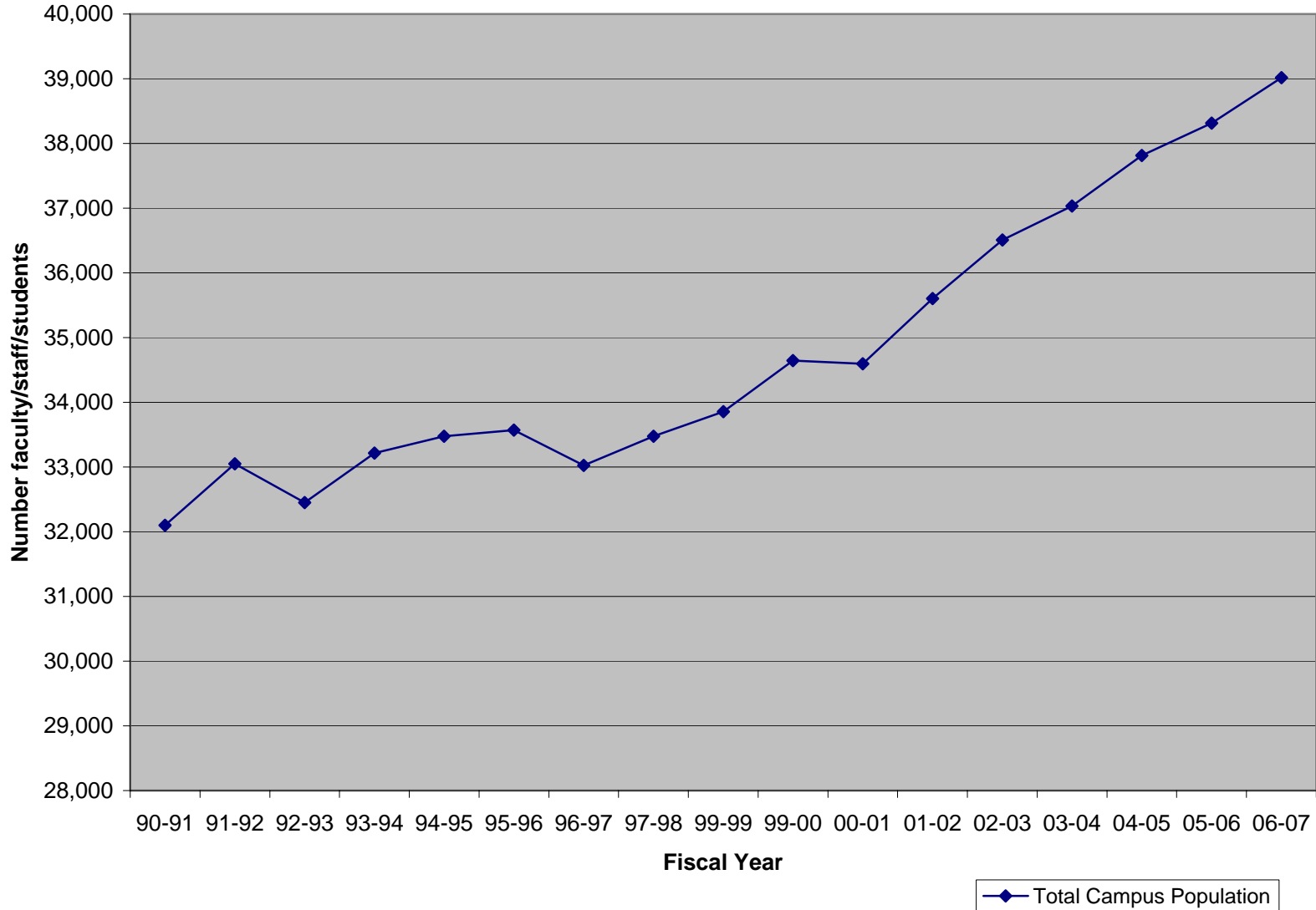

Total Campus Population, 1990-2006

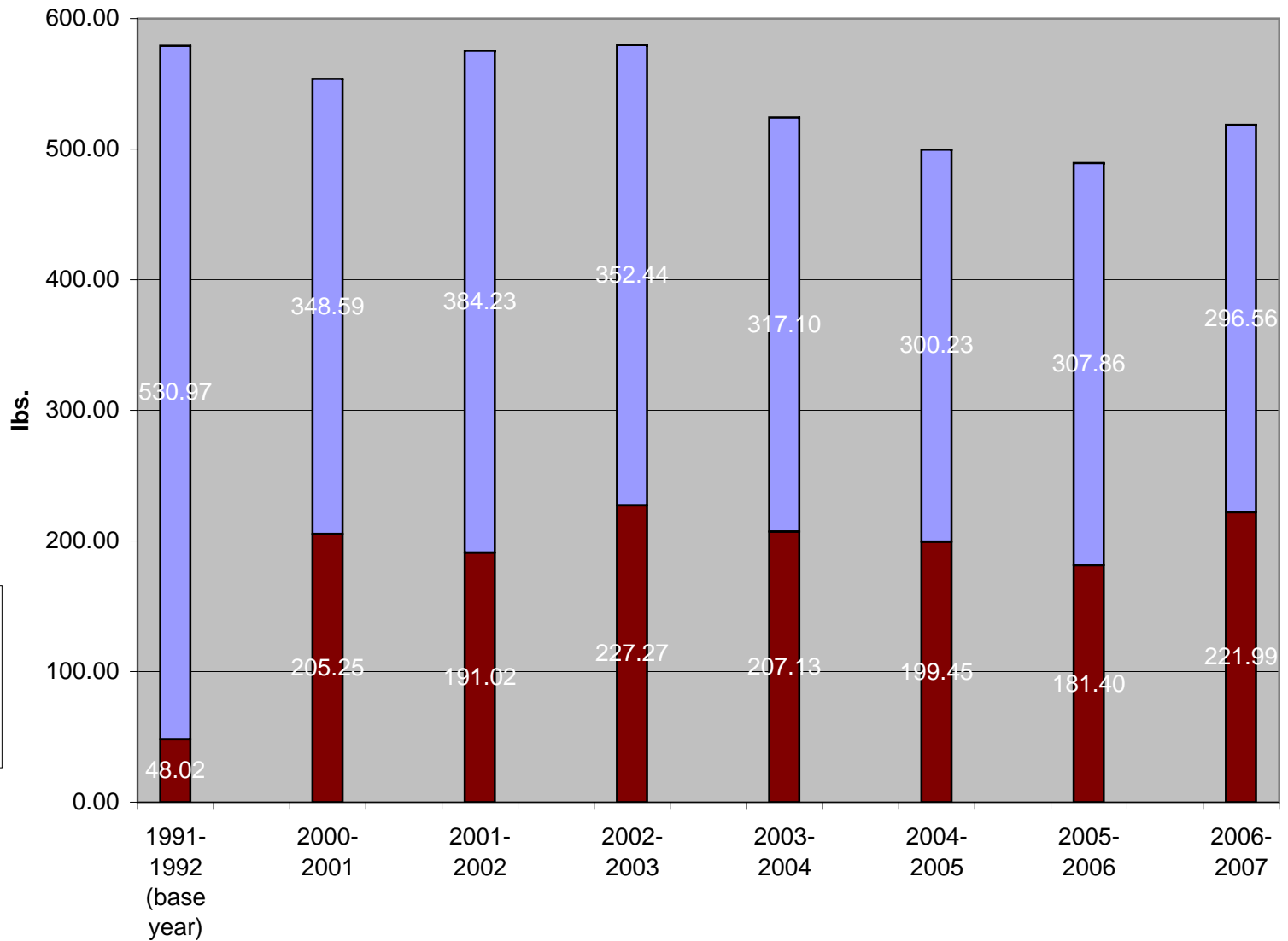

Per capita waste reduction from base year (1991-1992)

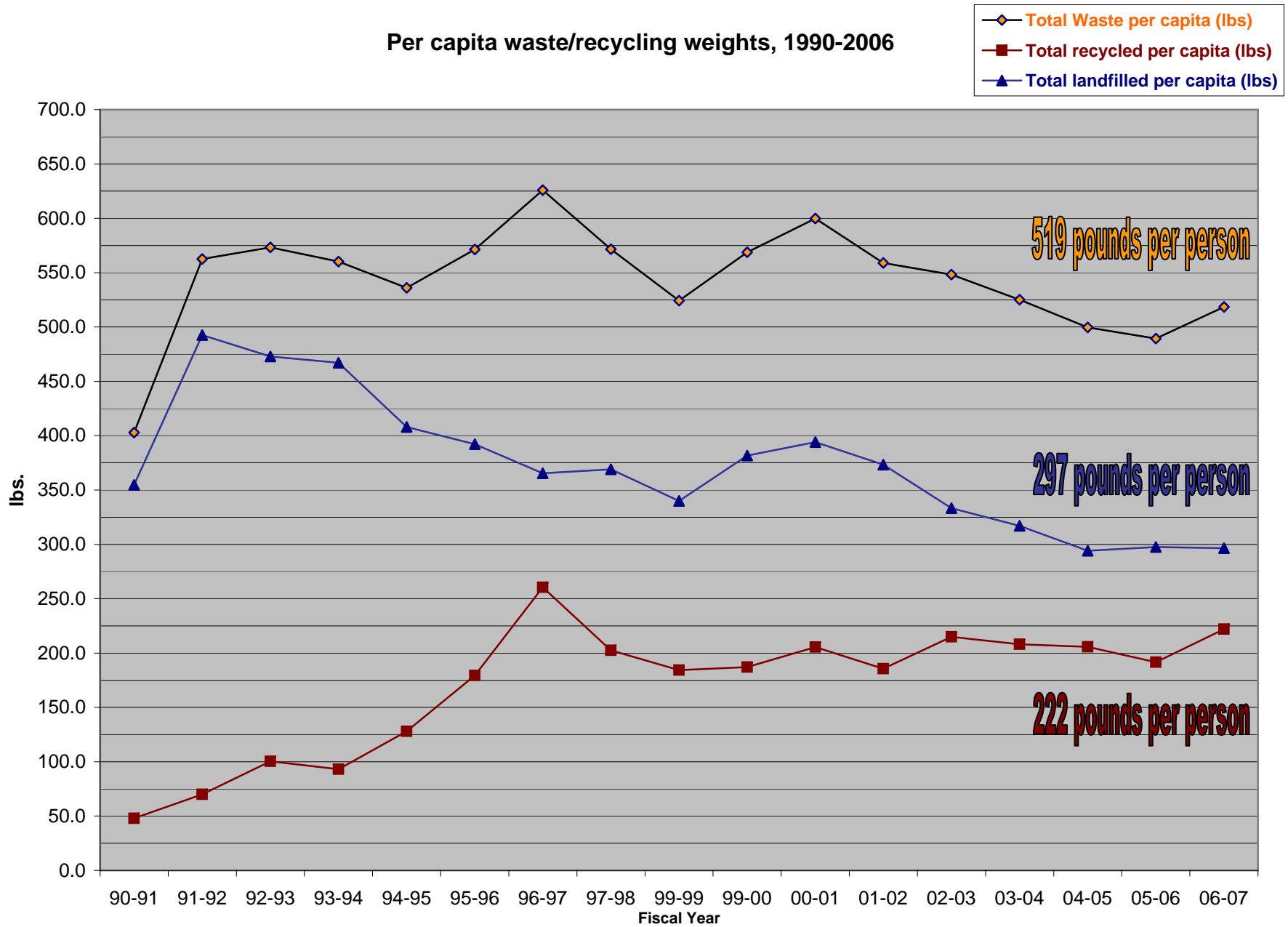
