The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (UNC or the University) submitted an air permit application received by the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (NC DEQ), Division of Air Quality (NC DAQ) on July 31, 2024, for the new engineered pelletized fuel project. We appreciate your review of the application. Since submitting the original application, the University has determined that the engineered pelletized fuel cannot meet fuel requirements (transportation, availability, consistency) set by UNC for its Cogeneration Power Plant. Therefore, UNC requests to withdraw Air Permit Application No. 6800043.24A for the new engineered pelletized fuel project.
